General Attendance at Events

You must be over 18 years of age to participate in the Jack Daniel's National BBQ Championship events (the 'Events'). ID will be checked upon entry and must be held at all times during the events. Attendance at all Events must be evidenced by a paid ticket from iTicket.

If you are bringing children under 18 years of age to the events, they must be under the strict supervision of a parent or an adult guardian at all times. The Promoter will not be held liable.

Tickets are non-transferable, non-exchangeable and non-refundable.

No refunds will be given for poor weather.

The Events will continue even in the event of inclement weather unless the safety of patrons are deemed to be adversely impacted.

The Promoter reserves the right to reschedule the Events and change locations.

All bags and containers may be subject to a full search.

No alcohol or alcoholic beverages are permitted at the Events. Attendees may bring their own food and non-alcoholic beverages for own consumption.

Participants to the Events must bring their own food to cook with, otherwise they are disqualified.

No antisocial paraphernalia is allowed. This includes but is not limited to weapons and gang patches.

Aggressive and/or intoxicated behaviour and any anti-social behaviour at the Events will not be tolerated and could result in eviction, which the Promoter reserves absolute right to implement.

The Promoter maintains the right to cancel ticket purchases of any persons who are deemed not to be suitable for this event.

Your lanyard must be worn at all times. If you lose or remove your lanyard, you will be unable to participate in the events.

Entry is at your own risk. The Promoter does not accept responsibility for any injuries, losses or damage sustained in or around the venues.

The Promoter reserves the right to refuse admission if valid identification of team registration is not provided or if tickets are lost or damaged.

Entrants consent to the Promoter and its agencies using their name, likeness, image and/or voice (including photograph, film and/or recording of the same) in any media for an unlimited period without remuneration for the purpose of promoting this promotion (including any outcome), and promoting any products manufactured, distributed and/or supplied by the Promoter.

Championship Entry Cost & Rules

Teams can only register to enter via iTicket.co.nz

Cost per team per event is NZ\$250.

Teams can have 1-4 people.

The maximum number of teams per event is limited to 30.

New Zealand based teams must compete in a minimum of 3 ABA Sanctioned Barbecue Competitions (in the Jack Daniel's National Barbecue Championship Series held in

New Zealand) within the 2017/18, 8-event series to be eligible for the overall Grand Champion Team prizes and to receive a National Ranking.

More than 3 competitions in the series can be entered.

The best three eligible hand-in scores from each event from that Team's best 3 competitions is tallied to reveal an overall Leaderboard score.

Hand-ins that are not Championship Series Categories are not eligible for Championship Points, prizes or Leaderboard tally (refer to 2017 ABA Rules – www.ausbbq.com.au/abarules).

A NZ National Ranking will only apply at the conclusion of the 2017/18 series with all Leaderboard rankings throughout the year being a provisional ranking for tally purposes only.

In the event of a tie for a Top 10 placing in the overall series, a count-back system will apply to break a tie in the following order:

- Team with most 1st Place Trophies from eligible categories from their 3 best 2017 events, wins the tie.
- Team with the most 1st, 2nd & 3rd Place trophies from eligible categories from their best 3 2017 events, wins the tie.
- Team with highest individual aggregate Round score from their best 3 2017 events, wins.
- Team with the highest individual category score from an eligible category from one of their best 3 2017 events, wins the tie.
- If still tied, teams will remain tied for that position and prizemoney will be combined and distributed evenly.



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Maximum of 4 Team Members only eligible per team to receive individual trophies/prizes.

Only New Zealand resident teams are eligible for NZ Jack Daniel's Grand Champion Team and New Zealand National Ranking for 2018.

NOTE: Any disputes arising in regards to trophies/prizes/prize money will be arbitrated by the Promoters in consultation with the ABA, with the Promoters' decision on any matter being final.

First place in each round at each event
- NZ\$300 + Trophy

Second place in each round at each event
- NZ\$150 + Trophy

Third place in each round at each event
- NZ\$100 + Trophy
